Now the parliament has passed the Budget Bill, I am writing in line with the Scottish Fiscal Commission's Framework Document, to confirm the funding for the Commission for the year 2019-20. As set out in the Scottish Budget, the Commission's funding for 2019-20 is £1,900,000.

The Framework Document also states that the Scottish Government will provide the Commission with an indication of funding for the subsequent 2 years, in line with best practice for Independent Fiscal Institutions. I have set out below indicative funding for the years 2020-21 and 2021-22. These figures reflect previous discussion of the Commission's projected expenditure and can be reviewed if circumstances change.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank you again for the work of the Commission and its staff to produce the forecasts which supported the budget process this year.
