Thank you for your email of 17 March to the Scottish Fiscal Commission, under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, requesting information about the salaries paid to Scottish Fiscal Commission staff.

The information you requested is as follows:

The above table is based on the salary paid to Scottish Fiscal Commission employees rather than the whole time equivalent.

It does not include agency or seconded staff, of whom there are two in total, neither of whom are paid more than £50,000 annually. Our four Commissioners are also excluded as they are fee paid appointments. I can confirm that their remuneration is less than £50,000 annually.





I can confirm that there are 13 employees with annual salaries of £50,000 or over, and there are no employees with an annual salary of £80,000 or over.
